

The symbol on the previous slide looks like the Nazi Swastika. In fact it is an Indian Swastika. In Hinduism and Buddhism the Swastika stands for good luck. In the Indian Swastika the "L" shape is inverted, unlike the Nazi counterpart.

It's often said that the Nazi Swastika is a disturbing symbol. The word symbol, in Greek, means "to throw together".

Sometimes the relationship between symbol and meaning is obvious. Other times, it is less apparent at first.






DIDACTICS clear, pragmatically delivered information with unambiguous meaning.






METAPHOR An image that would trigger an association
